Key responsibilities for this role:

- Assume responsibility for the management of monthly/weekly/daily haulage delivery requirements (900,000 tonnes annualised).
- Be the primary contact person regarding daily and weekly haulage issues/tasks.
- Create effective working and professional relationships with haulage contractors and customers.
- Be a visible leader in the field regarding log haulage safety. Be seen, and be well known as a leader and an advocate for a safe work place.
- Assist the Customer and Haulage Manager to forecast truck capacity and fleet requirements.
- Keep up to date and familiar with Chain of Responsibility legislation, and other relevant Codes such as the (current draft) Log Haulage Code of Practice.
- Report on and monitor log stocks in the forest and communicate with harvest contractors on log quality and cutting instructions.
- Assist the harvesting team and contractors achieve value recovery, log quality audits in the field and verification of reject logs in customers yards.

- Contemporary experience and/or relevant tertiary education in forestry and/or logistics.
- Experience working in an operational role that requires an urgency and immediacy to respond to and solve issues as they arise.

- Ability to efficiently manage, interrogate and analyse data, and to use and present information for effective problem solving and to inform decisions.
- Proficient in Microsoft suite of programs with an aptitude to develop proficiency in other software.
- Strong, proven communication skills.
- The ability to work collaboratively in a team environment.
